

1. USE OF COLLEGE CAR

Faculty are teaching in areas away from Nanaimo each night of the week, Monday - Thursday. If two faculty are off-campus the same night and are travelling to different areas, the one travelling farthest should, under normal circumstances, use the College car. Others using their personal car will be paid 12¢ per mile as calculated on the mileage chart. If the College car is available and a person chooses to use his or her own car, the mileage payment will be the same as the College pays for the College car -- 1½¢ per mile.
