HEALTH SERVICES

All students, staff and faculty members are encouraged to arrange for their own personal physician services.

For the benefit of those who are unwilling to do so, arrangements have been made with the Caledonian Medical Clinic for two physicians to be available.

PLEASE NOTE: The Clinic has a doctor on call seven days a week, 24 hours a day, to take emergency calls at the regular 'phone number, 753-3202. Again, you should identify yourself as a Malaspina College student so the appropriate Physician will be assigned to you.
