Go to or call Campus Services Clerk 746-3519 in Building 2
(September to April)

Anytime

1. Press red button on a yellow emergency call box outside of:

- Building 2 East Entrance (under walkway)
- Building 1 North Entrance (facing totems)
- Building 1 South Entrance (facing river)
- Building 1 East Entrance (facing Cowichan Native Village)
