

## FISH SERIES - 1 to 50

### STURGEON

There are two leading genera of this famous salt- and fresh-water fish, known as ordinary and shovel-nosed. The largest, known as the great white sturgeon, beluga, or huso of Pontocaspian waters, is frequently over 15 feet long and weighs 1,000 pounds. The white sturgeon of the Columbia and Sacramento Rivers weighs 300 to 600 pounds. The red, black, stone, rock, lake, and Ohio sturgeon, found in inland waters, weigh from 50 to 100 pounds. Sturgeon are the principal source of isinglass and caviar.
