Anielski is a rare talent; he not only theorizes, but is also a practical innovator. In this book, he challenges and reframes several core concepts and principles of economics. Drawing on his experiences as economic advisor to the Alberta government and his work on the Genuine Progress Indicator, he describes Genuine Wealth – his new economic model.
