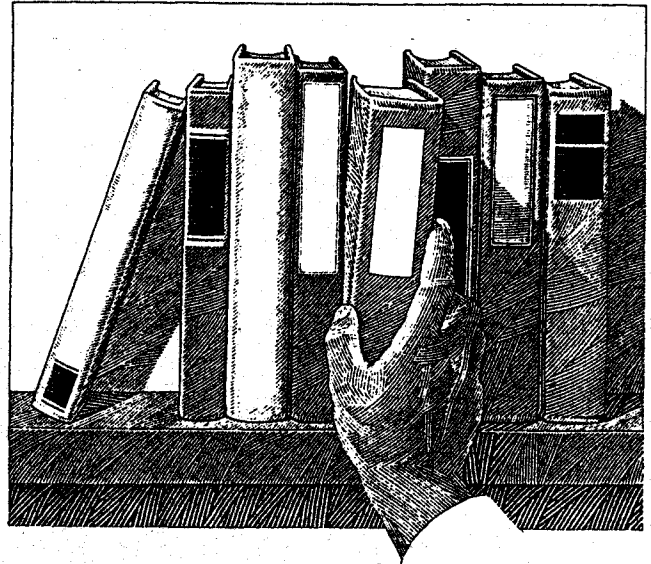
MISSING.....
